

Andrew McKean, Wildlife Advocacy

Andrew McKean lives outside Glasgow, where he writes about hunting, outdoor recreation, and conservation for a number of national publications. He's the former editor in chief of Outdoor Life, where he currently serves as the hunting and conservation editor. McKean started his career in newsprint, first as editor of the (Wolf Point, Mont.) Herald-News and later Rocky Mountain Fishing & Hunting News based in Helena and Seattle. He worked as Region 6 information officer for Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks before joining Outdoor Life as hunting editor, later executive editor, and finally editor in chief before he returned to freelance writing. He's a longtime hunter and bowhunter education instructor, coaches the Glasgow Scotties' track and cross country teams, and serves on the boards of Mule Deer Foundation and Wild Montana. He served briefly on the Montana Fish and Wildlife Commission. He raised three children on a working ranch outside Glasgow, where he hunts and fishes every chance he gets.
